

Scenes From Sunny Florida!

Many years ago I took the USPS Weather course and enjoyed it more than any of the other elective courses that I had taken. I don't know whether that was sentimental (my father had gone to school to become a meteorologist before being called into active duty during WWII) or just because I wanted to make sure I didn't get caught out in a bad storm!

One thing I have found in spending the winters now in Florida is that the weather can be very unpredictable. Normally severe thunderstorms are more likely to occur during the summer months, but we experienced some very scary weather on January 16th, with 8 waterspouts or tornadoes hitting the southern west coast of Florida. While most of them were fairly weak, there was one EF-2, meaning winds from 111-165 that destroyed 65 houses slightly north of Ft. Myers.

I took these pictures off of my deck as a waterspout made landfall on the Isle of Capri, directly across the river from me. I was very surprised and concerned to see boats headed down the river at the same time the tornado was headed up!

District 5 Spring Conference - Online Registration Instruction Instructions: Click on Member Registration on the home page of <abc-midatlantic.org>. You will have to give your membership number and password. This will then take you to the registration page.

Follow instructions below.

1. The Member section provides data from your membership record. See the Registration Instructions document linked below if there are issues.

2. Use the tools in the Spouse / Other Attendees section to add other members or guests.

a. Select name of an additional member from your squadron. Use the Add Additional Member button to add a select box.

b. Use the Add Guest Fields to add controls where you can type the names of other people who will attend.

3. Enter the number of entrees of each meal type you wish to purchase. Total cost will be automatically computed.

a. Click on the button **Automatically submit form to conference organizers** to save registration to conference database. Changes can be made to your registration as needed, up to the registration deadline of March 8, 2022. Of course, this may change the amount you owe.

After submittal, send a check to John Locke, 806 Harmony Way, Centreville, MD 21617.

Use the hotel link or phone number on the registration form to reserve a room. Be sure the USPS code is visible in the reservation page, Promotional Code field or is used by the hotel's reservation agent.







From the Galley! Shrimp Flatbread



Ingredients

Sheet Martin's Party Potato Rolls (12 rolls, still connected)
Ounces Small Pre-Cooked Shrimp (about 1 1/2 cups)
Medium Tomato, diced
Cup Artichoke Hearts, well-drained, chopped
Cup Green Onion, sliced
Teaspoon Fresh Garlic, minced
Teaspoon Salt
Cup Feta Cheese, crumbled
Slices Provolone Cheese, quartered
Cup Fresh Basil, chopped

Serves: 4

Directions

Heat oven to 400°F.

Cut the entire sheet of Party Potato Rolls in half using a sharp knife. Set the two halves side by side and roll flat with a rolling pin. This will be the crust for your flatbread.

Place flatbreads onto an ungreased baking sheet. Lightly brush with olive oil. In a medium bowl, toss together the cooked shrimp, tomato, artichoke, green onion, garlic, and salt until well mixed. Drain excess liquid, if necessary.

Spoon half of mixture onto each flatbread; top with feta and provolone cheese. Bake 7-10 minutes or until cheese is melted and bubbly. Check periodically to ensure rolls are not burning.

Remove flatbreads from oven. Sprinkle with fresh basil, if desired. Slice along the roll divisions; serve hot.
